On December 20, 2018, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved the Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services' (EOHHS) request to extend the Rhode Island's section 1115(a) demonstration (11-W-00242/1), entitled "Rhode Island Comprehensive Demonstration." In support of EOHHS' efforts to improve the Rhode Island Medicaid program, CMS approved several new waiver and expenditure authorities. CMS did not approve some of the requested waivers, including the waiver of the prohibition of services provided in an Institution of Mental Disease (IMD) for individuals with mental health conditions. EOHHS looks forward to working with CMS to receive approval for these waivers in 2019.
